Enrolment Fee

\$50 per family, non-refundable. Payable upon submitting the Enrolment Application Form.

The Family and School Tuition Fee is paid to Snowy Mountains Christian School for financial management of the school. This money is used to pay running costs such as: teacher and support staff salaries, building maintenance, ground maintenance, electricity & gas, land and water rates, phones, stationery, cleaning, and teacher and educational resources for students.

School Fees will be invoiced at the start of each term and payable within 30 days. Paying by instalments is welcome however please contact the Financial Administrator before doing so.

Sibling discounts:

For families with more than one child attending, the following sibling discounts apply to the tuition fees for all students from Kindergarten to Year 10:

Second child	10% discount
Third child	60% discount
Fourth and subsequent child	90% discount

Additional Charges

Uniform, books and stationery are an additional of cost for families, with the exact amount of each dependent upon the age and stage of the student. Excursions, camps, sports programs, and competitions will also attract a fee to parents, who will be notified prior to these activities. If students elect to complete distance education subjects, additional fees may apply.
